

1 DEFINE YOUR "WHY"

Needs vs. Wants:

- · Needs: Relaxation, pain relief, therapy, social gatherings.
- Wants: Luxury features, aesthetics, specific jet types, entertainment options.

Usage:

- · How often will it be used? (Daily, weekly, seasonally)
- · How many people will typically use it?
- · Will it be used year-round?

2 BUDGET & FINANCING
